- A person who has consistently volunteered their time, dedication and talents to the community and the citizens of the community to make it a great place to live, work, play and learn.
- A person who has made a positive difference in the lives of fellow citizens.
- Someone who is dedicated to St. James and concerned for others. They may have actively served on service, school, church, or community committees.
- A person who has shown a willingness to work with other St. James residents, who is enthusiastic about the town and its citizens, and who works continually towards the betterment of the community. A person with the qualities of honesty and integrity.
- A person who has performed an outstanding achievement or act of heroism
- Someone who has overcome significant personal adversity

Criteria for the Lifetime Achievement Award:

- Nominee must currently live or work in St James or the immediate surrounding area.
- Nominee must be age twenty-one (21) or older.
- The achievement (s) is based on a lifetime of dedicated service. To be eligible, the entire service is not required to have been done completely in the City of St. James and surrounding area.
- Nominations should be based on the qualities provided above and must show consistent service to make the community a better place to work, live and play.
