Public servants include: Firefighters, police officers, public health officials, & elected officials, Here are some of the values that should be evaluated in the nomination process:

- Problem-solving and critical thinking.
- Communication.
- The ability to influence others through reasoned argument.
- Respect for hierarchy.
- Resilience.
- The ability to work collaboratively.
- Leadership.
- A person who serves ethically and with integrity, Puts the interests of the public and the public service ahead of their own personal interests

Criteria for Public Servant of the year:

- Nominee must live or work the in St. James or immediate surrounding area.
- Nominee must be age twenty-one (21) or older.
- The achievement(s) on which the nomination is based must have occurred between January 1, 2023 and December 31, 2023 to be eligible.
- Nominations should be based on the qualities provided above.
